

CHILDREN AT THE RIVER CLUB

Everyone at The River Club enjoys hosting children of all ages as we are family orientated people to the core.



Extensive grounds set in Zambezi riverine forest high above the river means no crocodiles or hippos in the garden. Add to that **many on-site facilities** ideal for children to enjoy. Outdoors there's the infinity swimming pool with forever-views, the croquet / boulés lawn, a tennis court and nature trail. Indoors we have the 'Summerhouse' and snooker room, the small gym and the library adjoining the main living room where chess and other board games are kept. There is plenty to keep families with children occupied without leaving the property.

All The River Club **in-house activities** are also suitable for children; boat-related activities, game drives and other trips in our vehicles.

To help keep our young guests safe and happy at all times, one parent / guardian needs to be with their children when they play outside. In addition, before making a booking, please supply the full make-up of the group and proposed dates and length of stay. When there are children **younger than 6-years old** in a family group, **management at the lodge needs to be made aware of the booking and parents / guardians need to know and accept The River Club's CHILD POLICY.**

CHILD POLICY

The lodge infrastructure is *not geared specifically* for younger children or infants

- Even on request, it is just **not possible** to provide an infant cot.
- The River Club's Public Liability insurance does not allow us to provide a baby-sitting service.
- Parents or a parent (or official guardian) need to accompany their children at all times.
- Parents need to be aware that while the lodge gardens are safe from animals such as crocodiles, hippos and other large fauna, and is ideal for children to play and run around, the river-side boundary of the property is situated on a cliff-edge that leads straight down into the Zambezi River.
- There is plenty of space **away** from the cliff-edge, so as long as a parent is keeping an eye on their children to prevent them from venturing near the edge, there should be no problem.
- Likewise all guests, particularly children, are not permitted to explore down the stair case leading to the jetty where the lodge boats are moored.
- None of the swimming pools at the lodge are fenced or covered with safety nets.
- The lodge cannot be held responsible for anything that may go wrong with children under 6; hence parents need to supervise young children themselves.
- Parents need to be vigilant in their rooms too, due to balconies not being child-proof.
- Disturbance of any kind to other guests is to be avoided. Such disturbances would include tantrums, loud disciplining and crying.
