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The River Club is a long-standing, well-respected, official booking agent for all operators in the Livingstone, Chobe (Botswana) and Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe) areas. We have been compiling guest activity itineraries for many years and know exactly how all logistics and operator check-in times go together to ensure a seamless experience. All guests need do is send us an activity [wish list](#) so that we can combine activities to optimise the time you have with us and save on unnecessary back and forth transfers.

Planning activities and booking ahead is recommended as it avoids disappointment after arrival due to lack of availability. This applies especially to visits during busy times of the year.

- All prices are per person. When applicable, child rates are indicated.
- All prices INCLUDE return The River Club transfers charged one-way when we are the booking agent.
- External operators have the right to change prices without notice.
- External Operator Cancellation: in most cases 100% is due if cancelled less than 24-hours before, others its 48-hours.

SCENIC FLIGHTS – by advance reservation only

- ALL SCENIC FLIGHT PRICES EXCLUDE AVIATION TAX – currently USD 6 per person payable at the heli-pad / air-strip
  - Children u-2 no charge if they sit on a parents' lap; as long as they fit into the seat belt, children in their own seat pay full price
  - An I-Cloud link to video footage can be purchased direct from the operator after the flight

LIVINGSTONE ISLAND – by reservation only – the longer in advance the better

- The island is available seasonally with swimming in Angels or Devils Pool allowed only at medium and low water (respectively)
  - Minimum age on the island is 8-years - minimum age to swim is 12-years
  - Includes return boat ride and meal according to time slot booked
  - Dietary information is required in advance

THE ROYAL LIVINGSTONE EXPRESS restored STEAM TRAIN – advance reservation is required

- Advance booking for both trains is essential.
  - Minimum age is 3-years
  - Dietary information in advance is required
  - There is a cash-bar available for spirits
- Dinner on the Royal Livingstone Express Train - Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays
  - Enjoy a slow run from the siding in town down to the Railway Bridge; disembark to enjoy the sunset, then the slow ride back while dinner is served.
  - Dinner is a five-course affair served with beer, wine, soft-drinks and still water

THE FABULOUS ELEPHANT-CAFÉ – advance reservation is essential

- Elephant Interaction and Dining Experience
 

Enjoy a scenic boat ride through Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park, jumping rapids and game viewing along the way. Disembark at Ele-Café's jetty in the national park, and then enjoy an astonishing and highly educational elephant interaction with a group of rescue elephants. Complimentary photos and videos will be taken during the interaction which will be e-mailed to you afterwards. After all this excitement, sit down at the Café right on the rivers' edge and enjoy a unique award winning African-Indigenous-Fusion meal.

- Minimum age for elephant interaction is 10-years.
- Children of any age may enjoy the other aspects of this activity (full price)
- Menus are set by the Chef so all dietary information in advance is vital
- Two options; by road + boat or by road-only
- Advance booking is absolutely essential

WHITE WATER RAFTING – seasonal according to river levels

- Sign up for exciting grade-5 rafting in the famous Batoka Gorge
  - Minimum age is strictly 15 (accompanied by an adult)
  - This activity is not for the faint-hearted or the unfit
  - No previous experience is necessary
  - Please supply dietary information

- Helicopter Gorge Lift-out after rafting

After rafting, save the hike up and out of the gorge, and long drive back to town.

- Cost is in addition to rafting rate
- Exercise the option to experience a falls fly-over at same time!
- Minimum 4 pax and booking in advance is absolutely necessary

- Swimming Under the Spray – at very low water only

- This is a great add-on to White Water Rafting - the swim is first, then either exit the gorge just before Rapid #1 (the Boiling Pot) or continue with rafting.
- This activity entails some swimming and scrambling over rocks and boulders so a reasonable level of fitness, sense of balance and physical coordination is essential, as is appropriate footwear.

### CANOEING ON THE UPPER RIVER

This is not a strenuous activity and no previous canoeing experience is required. The guides will give you lessons on how to guide your craft before you set off.

- o Minimum age is 12-years, parents or guardians must accompany children
- o Pre-booking is necessary
- o Hard-body Canadian-type canoes are used
- o A great game & bird viewing experience while drifting down the river

### PRO-FISHING ON THE UPPER RIVER

Catch and Release Tigerfish and/or Bream. Choose spinning or fly fishing, no previous experience required as the professional guide will help you.

- o Under-12's welcome (parent or guardian must go with) - pays 50% of adult price
- o Pre-booking is required
- o All tackle is provided
- o Specify spinning (max 4) per boat or fly (max 2) per boat

### GAME / RHINO WALK

Unique to Livingstone, this is a slow walk in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park with a professional guide and a park scout. The pace is that of the slowest member of the group. The first portion of the walk is looking at all things large and small you come across. The last 20-minutes are spent on foot very close to however many rhino you manage to track.

- o Minimum age is strictly 12-years
- o Pre-booking is essential as only a maximum of 8-pax are allowed
- o Duration 2 ½ to 3-hours
- o Spend around 20-minutes on foot very close to rhinos

### PONY TRAILS

Enjoy this past-time on well-trained, friendly horses habituated to elephants. This professional stable is a few kilometres upstream of The River Club. Suitable for experienced and novice riders alike (please tell us your level of skill when you book). The trail runs through beautiful Zambezi woodland over a property that is a seasonal elephant corridor, and alongside the river.

- o Minimum age 9-years, parents or guardians must accompany children
- o Pony Tales for younger children; a groom leads the pony, parents are welcome to join on a bush meander on foot



Slots twice daily - early AM or later PM USD 110  
With Champagne Breakfast – 3-hours USD 130 (please supply dietary info)  
Pony Tales – ¾-hour USD 40 (while adults and older children ride or walk alongside)

- Multi-day Pony Trail experience in a remote part of western Zambia - enquire further if you would like a quote

### QUAD BIKING

Be prepared to get very dusty!

- o Minimum age 12-years – with a parent or guardian
- o This is a limited-number activity, therefore booking as far ahead as possible is best

Eco Trail 1-hour - max 5 per trip USD 125  
o Through the African Bush over humps, through ditches, around bends and down hills  
o The chance of meeting game along the way adds to the thrill of the trail

Village Trail 2 ½ hours - max 3 per trip USD 195  
o This trail takes you from Mukuni to Machenje Village over a dune, through dense bush and on to the Sichilobe Village  
o Stop for a refreshing drink, turn around and ... the adventure starts all over again!



### SEGWAY TOUR

Great fun for families with younger children; Segway machines are similar to a battery operated scooter which is controlled by the movement of the rider's weight.

- o Minimum age 7-years accompanied by parent or guardian
- o Each tour includes a 15 minute training session and a 30 minute Segway riding tour
- o There is a good chance you will see zebra, giraffe and antelope
- o Helmets and bottled water provided
- o Booking is required – maximum 10 pax

## CROSS-BORDER ACTIVITIES

Cross-border activities have visa and extra-time implications. Please discuss this in full with Operations at The River Club to ensure you buy the right visa to allow border crossings while staying with at The River Club.

- Visas are for guests own account. The special KAZA visa saves time and costs – 40 nations qualify.

### ZIMBABWE-SIDE VICTORIA FALLS TOURS

There are a variety of choices if you prefer to go on a guided tour. However, self-guided trips can be undertaken inexpensively and easily without booking a tour – we will tell you how.

- Guided tours include park fees and all transfers unless otherwise indicated

- Self-Guided Zimbabwe-side Tour of Falls

- The walk from Zimbabwe Immigration is very short and it's impossible to get lost

One-way OR Return Transfer: The River Club to Zimbabwe Immigration USD 42

One-way Taxi Transfer Zim-Immigration to lodge: for Zim visits of more than 2-hours USD 50 – pay the driver direct

Zimbabwe-falls park entry fees: Pay your own at the entrance USD 30 - carry USD in CASH

- If you would like to visit Victoria Falls town on the same trip as seeing the Zimbabwe-side of the falls, we can book a Zimbabwe taxi driver well known to us - guests pay the driver direct in USD cash

### ELEPHANT ACTIVITIES - ZIMBABWE

The rates for the two activities listed here includes a Conservation levy, The River Club transfer to Zimbabwe Immigration, guests find own way to Kingdom Hotel (it's a short walk), the Zimbabwe operator transfers from the Kingdom Hotel to the site outside the town of Victoria Falls, and the operator transfers cross-border all the way back to The River Club. Booking ahead is necessary.

- Minimum age 5-years
- Children 5 to 11 years pay the child rate
- Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian

Ele-Encounter and Walk with Giants USD 210 12 & above USD 120 5-11 years

Talk to the guides and learn more about the complexities of the individual elephants and the herd structure, as well as their history and how they came to be here. Guests will then spend time with the elephants.

- Witness the special relationship the elephant keepers share with the animals and become a part of it.
- Take photographs and marvel at their size while watching them behaving normally; browsing and interacting with one another.



Ele-Art Safari includes art materials and lunch USD 245 12 & above USD 140 5-11 years

Enjoy an educational presentation at the Elephant Sanctuary & Orphanage. Learn about the elephants and their history and how they came to be here, as well as the threats facing elephant populations today.

- At the waterhole-mud wallow where, under the shade of an enormous Mopane tree, find a chair and easel with a fresh sheet of paper
- Radiantly coloured aprons and palettes with bright splotches of paint are provided
- A private tutor guides guests through a painting workshop
- Afterwards enjoy a delicious 2-course buffet lunch with a cold beverage – please provide dietaries in advance



### CANOPY TOUR - ZIMBABWE

Good fun for the whole family. You can turn up and take your chances, but booking ahead is always best.

- No minimum age though younger children go in harness with an adult
- The site is on the side of the gorge (not on the Railway Bridge)
- Short walk (10 minutes) from Zimbabwe Immigration to the site
- Duration is 2 ½ hours
- First check-in is 08:45, then hourly thereafter until last check-in at 14:45

Canopy Tour USD 61 – no reduction for children

- Park Fees USD 3 – pay direct on-site



### CHOBE DAY TRIP - BOTSWANA

This activity includes Chobe River Cruise and Chobe National Park Game Drive; return road transfers to Kasane, lunch and all park fees.

- **Important Note:** Parents of minor children must carry unabridged birth certificates to visit Botswana

- Minimum age 12-years - please enquire further if you have younger children
- Depart the lodge around 07:00 return around 17:45 – it really is a full day out
- Operator needs to know in advance if there are any dietary requirements
- Advance booking is essential
